



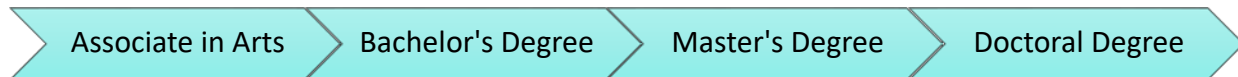
Psychology Transfer Plan -FAU- Associate of Arts 1010
