

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MIAMI DADE COLLEGE, FLORIDA

AND

THE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BROWARD COLLEGE, FLORIDA

### I. Parties

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made by and between the **District Board of Trustees of Miami Dade College, Florida** (MDC), located at 300 N.E. 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132, on behalf of its **School of Entertainment and Design Technology (SEDT)** and the **District Board of Trustees of Broward College, Florida** (BC), located at 3501 Davie Road, Davie, Florida 33314. Collectively, both MDC and BC shall be referred to as the “Parties.”

### II. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to create a transfer pathway that allows graduates of BC’s Associate in Science (AS) in Film Production Technology Program to seamlessly enroll into MDC’s Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) in Film, Television, and Digital Production.

### III. Provisions

- A. Guaranteed admission to MDC BAS in Film, Television, and Digital Production for graduates of BC’s AS in Film Production Technology Program.
- B. AS graduates must complete 21 credits of general education requirements (18 credits) and upper division electives (3 credits).

### IV. Collaboration and Coordination

- A. During the period of this MOU, MDC and BC will collaborate on the following initiatives:
  - i. Identify and advertise this opportunity to prospective AS graduates.
  - ii. Connect prospective students with faculty and staff of MDC’s School of Entertainment and Design Technology.
  - iii. Share annual data regarding the number of students who transfer under the terms of this MOU.

### V. Term, Termination, and Other Provisions


- A. The term of this agreement shall be for three (3) years commencing on the date this MOU is fully executed by the parties. It may be renewed by written agreement of the parties for two (2) additional three-year terms.
- B. Either party may send written notice of terminating the MOU a minimum of ninety (90) days prior to the effective date of the termination.
- C. If this MOU is terminated by either party, such termination will not affect the status of students already in the pipeline who will be able to continue to receive the benefits of the agreement.
- D. Any modification to this MOU must be made in writing and signed by both Parties.


This MOU between the District Board of Trustees of Miami Dade College and the District Board of Trustees of Broward College, Florida was executed by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties on this 14 day of May, 2020.
